The Olympics will be held in France this summer, with Paris the host city! In addition to the usual French Club curriculum we will focus on vocabulary which will be useful whether attending the games, or watching them over the summer. Lunchtime French Club runs in the summer term for 10 weeks starting in the w/c 15 April, as follows:

For Years 3 - 6: Thursdays, 12.15 – 12.45, in the demontable classroom.

In French Club there is an emphasis on **spoken French**, to develop confidence in French, and an interest in France and French culture. The club is for children with no prior knowledge of the language, together with returning children. For year 6 children, French Club prepares for year 7, when there will be an emphasis on spoken French.

The fee is £55.00 for 10 lessons, starting on Thursday, 18 April.

A French Club book which covers the whole French course for the school year is available for an additional £7.00. Each "cahier" backs up the French covered each week and makes it easy to see what your child is learning, with each page corresponding to one lesson in French Club. The book is designed for home use only, as we concentrate in the club on speaking and listening. There are 6 different books in total. If your child did French Club in the spring or autumn term you don't need to buy a book this term.
