Associate Governors are non-voting and are not specified in the Articles but are recognised by the Trust as a post appointed by the LGB themselves

Based on that fact that the current "co-opted" governor was appointed without voting rights

Maintains the required Foundation Governor majority of 2 over the total of all other voting categories

Foundation Governors are formally appointed by the Diocese (via the LGB and Trust)

The Term of Office is 4 years except for a co-opted governor which is 1 year but can be re-appointed by the LGB if they so wish (note that in the first instance the current community governor that is migrating to the co-opted post will carry with them the end of term date of 5.7.27. EXCEPT the Headteacher (termed as "principal" in the Articles) and is ex-officio so no end date

Foundation Governors can be re-appointed, upon request, by the Diocese at the end of their term of office

Elected Governors can be re-elected at the end of their term of office
